This was the first year that the South West and Welsh clubs held their own regional championships at Hartpury, **LCRC** sent a team to do dressage, show jumping and style jumping, more great results, the team members: Sarah and Rosie Wharton, Alice Wyatt and Fiona Bengier, came second in the dressage, Fiona, Sarah and Rosie all had individual placings, the team was also placed in the style jumping with Sarah Wharton coming second individually, and individual placings for the other three members, the same team was placed in the show jumping with Fiona gaining an individual placing. Definitely worth trying to qualify again next season, lots of fun and not so far to travel.

LCRC members have had so many numerous wins and placings, at Area 12 competitions, too many to mention individually, except the most recent win for the senior dressage team (Jane Rogers, Kate Jupp, Wendy Kiy and Fiona Bengier) who won the Area 12 winter dressage at KSEC with three team wins, Sarah Wharton won as an individual, winning 5 out of the 6 classes, pretty impressive by any standards.

The senior award for the highest placed member at championship level went to Sarah Wharton for her second in the style jumping at Hartpury, this was awarded at the AGM. We have introduced a new award: "The grassroots silver horse shoe" this was awarded to Christine Hill for her achievement in her first season doing club teams in all disciplines.

Rides continue to be very popular, Thank you to Brenda who does a fabulous job organising these rides for club members to enjoy, along with the social lunch after! The committee has organised some good talks for you in Jan & Feb, along with a full schedule of other events.
